
OUR THEME FOR 2022: "EACH ONE BRING ONE"

We are excited by the ways our group continues to evolve – and we would like more people to experience the fun and sense of community that the BTS offers to the world of Betsy-Tacy fans.

For 2022, we're officially launching **Each One Bring One**. Our dream is that **every current BTS member will invite or purchase a membership for one more person**, which would bring our membership to 1,000!

Please use the enclosed membership form to renew your own membership (check the expiration date on your mailing label) and/or to give a gift membership. (Make as many copies as you like!)




FINANCIAL REPORT


Here are some ways to financially support the organization:

ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF 2021

- So many newsletters! Two for adult and senior members: *Deep Valley Sun* (print) and *The Agony Column* (e-news). Two for younger members: *Everything Pudding* (print) and a Betsy-Tacy YA E-Blast. We produced several issues of each in 2021.
- The number of BTS members has increased by more than 20% since 2020.
- We now offer memberships for four distinct age groups (including a brand-new YA membership), with special benefits for each group.
- This year about a dozen members joined us from outside the U.S. We are very excited to grow our international member database.
- We expanded our Board of Directors and

Advisory Council, adding some new folks with valuable skills and ideas – including the daughters of Shirley Lieske, a BTS founding member.

- We hosted several well-attended and fun virtual events via Zoom.
- We added some exciting new products to our Shop and ensured that every book in the series is again available for purchase.
- Shop sales were up significantly from 2020 no small feat during a pandemic!
- We beefed up our social media presence. You can now find the BTS on Tumblr, Twitter, Instagram, and YouTube, and we have more than 5,000 followers on Facebook.

GOALS FOR 2022

- Reopen the Houses as soon as we can.
- Double our memberships.
- Launch a new and improved website we're *very* close!
- Learn how to write grants and attract some grant-writing volunteers. We'd love to upgrade the office technology at Tacy's House (the computer is circa 2009!). Our beautiful Houses need ongoing restoration. A long-term ambition is to renovate the basement at Betsy's House so visitors can see how the Hart family actually used their cellar. We believe that grants are available to help us achieve each of these goals.
- Create and post more YouTube videos.

- Purchase a full-size Square card reader for our Shop and make it easier for customers to pay with a credit or debit card, rather than PayPal.
- Plan and host more events (virtual *and* in-person, if possible).
- Survey members to find out what products they'd like to see in the Shop.
- Do something creative and fabulous with the beautiful maple wood from a tree that Betsy's father planted in 1892. (Tom Hart planted two trees; one was felled by lightning in 2003, but one still proudly stands at Betsy's House.)
- Organize the many items donated by our generous supporters in 2021.


REFLECTIONS ON RUNNING A SMALL MUSEUM DURING A PANDEMIC

It's the question we've been asked this year more than any other: *When will you reopen?*? We are as eager to reopen as you are to see the Houses again – but here's what we're thinking about as we consider this decision:

- The safety of our volunteers, many of whom are over 60. Volunteers must supervise visitors in very small quarters – social distancing is simply not possible inside the Betsy and Tacy Houses.
- Whether we can or should require visitors to be vaccinated.
- What to do if people argue about wearing a mask or sharing their vaccination status.
- How to handle large groups of unvaccinated children.

Our number-one concern is the safety of our volunteers and visitors. We thought we could reopen in June, and then the Delta variant threw us for a loop. We hope to open the Houses in spring 2022 – but none of us have a crystal ball. We simply have to wait and see.

We are considering other options, such as virtual tours or lightly monitored self-tours using tablets, all of which will require time and funds.



But in the meantime, the BTS is active and healthy. We'll continue to post regularly on social media, create and send six newsletters per year, host events on Zoom, fill Shop orders, and respond as creatively as we can to this challenging situation. **Thank you for your patience!**
