What's the connection between our favorite Minnesota author, a classic 1930s monster movie, and a popular video game?

King Kong, Minnesota. Population: Mario tells the story of how Delos Lovelace's great pal Merian Cooper tapped Delos to write the novelization of his movie King Kong. Sixty years later, Nintendo introduces the Donkey Kong video game, featuring Mario (from Super Mario Bros) attempting to rescue a damsel from a giant angry ape.

The article is great fun, but the best part is the accompanying five-minute video. Though the narrator mispronounces Delos's name (it's de-LOSS, not DELL-ose), the video mentions *Betsy-Tacy* and includes an adorable photo of teenage Merian Lovelace (Maud and Delos's daughter, named for family friend Mr. Cooper) on a bicycle.
